

## **Directions for pedestrians from Barrow railway station to the Dock Museum**

To walk from the railway station exit to the entrance of the Dock Museum is a distance of 1,610 metres: exactly one mile.

On leaving the station, head for the Furness Building Society office building with the statue of Emyln Hughes, (former England football captain), outside.

Turn right down Abbey Road. On the opposite side of the road you will see the Duke of Edinburgh hotel and Cooke's Studios. Walk straight down the road for 460 metres, (500 yards), to the roundabout with a statue of Sir James Ramsden in the centre.

Carry on over the roundabout and walk for 180 metres, (200 yards), until you reach a small roundabout. You will pass 'The Range' store on your right on this part of your walk.

Turn right onto Hindpool Road and cross to the other side using the pedestrian crossing, continue with Tesco Extra on your left and after 100 metres, (110 yards) you will reach another roundabout.

Turn left down North Road and walk for 180 metres, (200 yards), until you reach the pedestrian crossing opposite Brewer's Fayre.

Cross the road, and to your left, you will see the Dock Museum building. Follow the signs around the building to our main entrance.
